
Brenda: I am thankful...to Coho for the opportunity to practice open hearted

tolerance of differences.


Judy: I am thankful...that as a community we are stronger than we are alone because as individuals we could never have moved ahead. This is a true community effort.

Shirley: I am thankful...for the professionalism and attention to detail in building the internal structure of our community.






Juva: I am thankful...to people that know me well enough that I can be my imperfect self and still be loved.
