## Work Party

Coho holds work parties once a month, usually the third Sunday of the month. We gather and list off the various projects in need of doing, then we split up into smaller groups to work. Projects vary each month, mostly outside work on the grounds/gardens, helping prepare lunch in the common house, maintenance projects, etc.
